Dear Mr. Portera:

On behalf of the Council On State Taxation (COST), I am writing to request the Department withdraw or hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments to Miss. Admin. Code 35.IV.5.06. The proposed amendments would impose the State's sales tax on remote internet-based computer services, which is a departure from longstanding practice and represents a significant tax policy change that should be addressed by the Legislature. It also raises several unanswered questions, including whether the proposed changes will be applied retroactively.

COST's objective is to preserve and promote equitable and nondiscriminatory state and local taxation of multijurisdictional business entities, many of which conduct business in Mississippi.

Conclusion
